Answer: The children are near the sea/on the sand. (Pointing to the children is also acceptable).

Answer: The seagull is next to/in front of the picnic blanket. (Pointing to the seagull is also acceptable).

Answer: The mum is below the parasol/on the picnic blanket/to the right of the dad. (Pointing to the mum is also acceptable).

Answer: The dad is below the parasol/on the picnic blanket/to the left of the mum. (Pointing to the dad is also acceptable).

Answer: The seagull is watching the food.

Answer: The children are building a sandcastle.

Answer: The mum is holding a red apple.

Answer: The girl is holding a blue spade.

Answer: They are in the sand because they are playing/ building a sandcastle.

Answer: The seagull is near the picnic because it wants to eat their food.

Answer: The boy is holding a bucket of sand because he is building a sandcastle.

Answer: The family is at the beach because they are on holiday.
